These briefs are from the Kentucky Health Issues Poll (KHIP), funded by the Foundation for a Healthy Kentucky and Interact for Health. The Kentucky Health Issues Poll has been conducted annually by the Institute for Policy Research at the University of Cincinnati beginning in 2008. Each year, a random sample of about 1,600 adults from throughout Kentucky is interviewed by telephone, including landline interviews and cell phone interviews with cell phone users. There are other sources of variation inherent in public opinion studies, such as nonresponse, question wording, or context effects that can introduce error or bias.
